



## **Instructions from Tallinn to Tartu**

We will provide you with some instructions to arrive at <u>Tartu</u> without further ado. After the plane lands at <u>Tallinn Airport</u> and you have passed through the baggage claim, you should look for the sign that says *Ühistransport* / Public transport. The intercity bus stop is located on the right side of the airport building. This is where the bus to Tartu takes off. The bus tickets can be bought online at <a href="https://luxexpress.eu/en/">https://luxexpress.eu/en/</a> or in the bus station from the ticket machines (only in case of vacancies). It is recommended to purchase tickets beforehand in order to avoid unpleasant situation where the tickets could be sold out. While buying the ticket, make sure to choose the right departure stop (<u>Tallinn Airport</u>) and destination stop (<u>Tartu Coach Station</u>). Then choose the correct departure date. You can also travel to Tartu <a href="bytrain">bytrain</a>, but the train station is further away from the airport, so we suggest you take the bus.

When arriving in Tartu, you should get off the bus at the last stop, which is **Tartu Coach Station**. The <u>Dorpat Hotel</u>, where you will be staying throughout your stay in Tartu, is located right next to the bus station. The address of the hotel is **Soola 6, 51013 Tartu**.

## Instructions to Tartu city centre from the Ülenurme Airport

If your flight is arriving at <u>Tartu Airport</u>, you should follow these instructions. The airport is in Ülenurme, which is located 10 km from the Dorpat Hotel. As there is no convenient public transportation to take you to the city centre nor back to the airport upon leaving, it is recommended to use taxi service.

The taxi service providers like **Bolt** and **Uber** are quite affordable for this purpose. You could also use providers like Tartu Taksopark (dial number +372 730 0200) or Tartu Linna Takso (dial number +372 736 6366) that offer price rate 1.90€ per minute. Average <u>taxi fares</u> are around 11–14 EUR.

## **Instructions from Tartu back to Tallinn**

We hope that you will be leaving Estonia with a good feeling of accomplishment following the conference. After checking out of the hotel, go to the Tartu Coach Station that is next to the hotel. Tickets can be bought online or in the station from the ticket machines. Once again, it is recommended to buy the tickets in advance as they could be sold out due to busy inter-city travelling during the summer season. When arriving in Tallinn, the bus stops at **Tallinn Airport** before the Tartu Coach Station stop. Therefore, you should pay attention to the driver's announcements upon arriving. At the airport, follow the signs to the check-in counters. We wish you a pleasant flight back home!

If you wish to spend the weekend in Tallinn after the conference, the capital city has a lot to discover. When it comes to accommodation, Tallinn city centre has various hotels amongst which many are close to the main city sights. We recommend staying at <u>Radisson Hotel</u>. It has great transportation access, including taxi service. It takes approximately 10 minutes to get to the airport by taxi (Bolt, Uber or local taxi service providers) and 15 minutes by bus no. 2 (Mõigu) or bus no. 15 (Sõjamäe).
