The theme of the workshop is "Use of Operation Indicators and Measurements in External and Internal Evaluation in Schools".

The aims of the workshop is to share the experience of Estonia and to exchange experience with other countries.

## Themes for discussion

- Data usage and analysis of performance measuring in educational institutions
- Disclosure of data and the pros and cons of disclosure
- Usage of data based on risk-based inspection
- Review of the Estonian education system, Estonia compared to other states, national data inventory.
- Evaluating educational institutions from the perspective of state, owner and head of school based on the example from Finland, data disclosure or non-disclosure, pros and cons of disclosure.
- Risk assessment how the performance of school is evaluated, what data is used, based on what data the decisions are made to decide the need of supervision.
- Introduction of applicable grading systems used in different educational institutions, including usage of data: what data schools are using for analysis, how much do they disclosure. Class observation.
