# "Inspection and school autonomy: Benefits and challenges in a changing world"

The aim of the workshop is to explore how inspection systems have evolved and have effect across educational systems that give recognition to school autonomy in varying ways and in different circumstances. The workshop will provide participants with the opportunity to hear about and discuss the experience of several countries, including Estonia where schools have extensive autonomy which allows them to conduct their own necessary methods in terms of shaping the school environment. Participants at the workshop will be facilitated to reflect on the key learning from the experience of different Inspectorates and on how this might potentially transfer to their own inspection context.

The workshop will also provide an opportunity to hear about and discuss the success of Estonia in PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment) and the factors that contributed to this successful change in the performance of Estonian students. #### Accommodation

SICI Estonia working group team has an agreement of fixed prices with Hotel Dorpat in Tartu, therefore, we recommend planning you stay there when booking accommodation. <u>Hotel Dorpat</u> is located in Tartu city centre, in the middle of the main business area. The hotel is also an easy stroll from the Old Town and major shopping centres. Many rooms enjoy views over the city or the Emajõgi River – scenes of Tartu you'll never forget!

A **special accommodation rate** at Dorpat applies for the SICI 2024 delegates:

- Standard single room: **60 EUR** 

- Standard twin/double room: **80 EUR** 

The special price is valid for the rooms that have been booked for 12<sup>th</sup> until 16<sup>th</sup> of June. We have reserved 15 rooms for 11<sup>th</sup> until 12<sup>th</sup> of June as well if anyone has planned their arrival a day earlier. The same discount price applies for this occasion.
